



Kingsdown Pre-school Online Safety Policy

Kingsdown Pre-school acknowledges that online learning is an important and useful tool which can support children's learning and development. However, we understand the need to safeguard children from unsuitable content, including images and information, both in the setting and at home.

We do this by:

- Teaching children in an age appropriate way through conversations and posters, how to keep themselves safe online
- Always fully supervising children when accessing the internet in the setting
- Only using programs/websites with age appropriate and relevant content to enhance and extend their learning
- Providing parents with information and links to keep children safe online at home
- Keeping up to date with information from the Education Safeguarding Service

Staff only go online on the pre-school computer to access the setting emails, complete online referrals, and to research suitable programs to support children's learning and development.
