



Kingsdown Pre-school Fundraising policy

It is the trustees of Kingsdown Pre-school who must ensure we comply with the law relating to fundraising and that best practice is followed in all aspects; fundraising methods, costs involved, financial risks, and how the money is spent.

The trustees must consider the impact the fundraising methods will have on public opinion and the reputation of the Pre-school within the community.

We must be mindful and respect all the organisations in the village needing to raise money.

Any fundraising pitch will be prepared very carefully so that there is clarity about the need for additional funds. Benefits to the setting will be promoted and how the supporter will gain will be explained too. Whenever fundraising for a specific resource, the money raised will be used solely to purchase that resource.

As we are a registered charity, we are accountable to the Charity Commission so trustees will ensure that all charity fundraising rules are followed. (www.charity-commission.gov.uk)
